Bell UH-1H "Huey" Helicopter

The museum's UH-1H helicopters are multipurpose utility aircraft, famous for this service during the Vietnam War. Originally designated "Iroquois" by the U.S. Army, the aircraft acquired the nickname "Huey" because of its original HU-1 (Helicopter, Utility-1) military description. Used primarily

as troop transports, the "Huey" was also used in medical

evacuation, cargo resupply, and aerial gunship roles. The museum's two aircraft are both Vietnam veterans; #16265 flew 1,375 hours from October 1969 to June 1971. Aircraft #16215 flew 874 hours from October 1969 to April 1971. Both are available for visitors to climb aboard and experience these articles of American history.



New Exhibits Coming Soon

This October, a group of aviation maintenance students and staff from Lewis University will be working to reassemble the A-4M Skyhawk II and the A-7E Corsair that are staged behind the museum. Plans are being made to assemble the Douglass F3D Skyknight in 2022. Once complete, the aircraft are going to need work to make them display worthy, so watch for opportunities to volunteer next year!
